I refer to the above Biodiversity Certification Application for Jacaranda, Glossodia which is subject to Biodiversity Certification under Part 7AA of the repealed Threatened Species Conservation Act 1995 which has now been replaced with the Biodiversity Conservation Act 2016.

At its Ordinary Meeting on 27 April 2021, Council resolved to submit the Biodiversity Certification Application documentation (post-exhibition amendments) for the Jacaranda Development to the Environment, Energy and Science Group of the Department of Planning, Industry and Environment for assessment and to make the necessary arrangements with the Minister for Environment & Energy to confer the Biodiversity Certification Application.


In accordance with Section 126N of the repealed Threatened Species Conservation Act 1995 and a requirement of the Environment, Energy and Science Group of the Department of Planning, Industry and Environment, public notice of the exhibition of the Biodiversity Certification Application, Report and Strategy - Jacaranda, Glossodia was placed in the Sydney Morning Herald on Tuesday, 23 February 2021. In addition, public notice of the exhibition of the Planning Proposal and supporting documentation including the Biodiversity Certification Application, Report and Strategy was placed in the Hawkesbury Courier local newspaper on Thursday, 25 February 2021.

The Biodiversity Certification Application documentation was publicly exhibited for the period Thursday 25 February 2021 to Sunday 28 March 2021. Council received no submissions from the community with respect to the Biodiversity Certification Application, Report and Strategy.

In accordance with Council's resolution of 27 April 2021 and Section 126N of the Threatened Species Conservation Act 1995, a copy of the Biodiversity Certification Report and Strategy Version 9 (post-exhibition) reflecting the community consultation, supporting documentation and the updated Biodiversity Certification Application Form incorporating the following post-exhibition amendments are forwarded for assessment and determination:

- Amended the size of Conservation Area 1 in Section 4 as 12.01ha.
- Amended Southern Myotis credit requirements in Section 6 and Section 9 in accordance with the Biodiversity Certification Report and Strategy (Version 9).
- Replaced Cumberland Land Snail with Dural Land Snail in Section 9 in accordance with the Biodiversity Certification Report and Strategy (Version 9).
