Kosciuszko National Park wild horse rehoming program: 2024–25 financial year

- The annual return collects and aggregates data at a program level so that NPWS can identify the overall proportion of horses provided under the rehoming program that have been retained, euthanised, died, sold or transferred. The return is not intended to track the welfare of individual horses.
- The annual program return is a requirement of the NPWS *Domestication (rehoming) Guidelines*. Non-compliance with the guidelines may lead to ineligibility to participate in NPWS wild horse rehoming programs.
